1. Send final and summer college transcripts (unless the courses were taken at OSU) to the Student Affairs Office, 150 Parks Hall, 500 West 12<sup>th</sup> Ave, Columbus OH 43210
2. Sign off on the Honor Code Commitment form and submit to the Student Affairs Office. (<http://www.pharmacy.ohio-state.edu/services/students/studentaffairs.cfm>)
3. Complete a background check and submit the information to the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy. (<http://pharmacy.ohio.gov/>)
4. View your financial aid status, sign your electronic promissory note, complete entrance counseling, sign up for direct deposit, and accept your student loans using the links and information on your Student Center page at (<http://buckeyelink.osu.edu/>). Clicking on the "View Financial Aid" link in the Finances section and then clicking on the "2010" Aid Year link will give you access to all critical financial aid information.
